#1) Ridiculously Delicious Nut Butter Company Chunky Crunch

Syrupy when you pick it up on a spoon, and almost creamy in the mouth, I'm not sure what sorcery has been used to achieve that texture and the crunch, but I like it. (Side note: did you know you can get "smunchy" peanut butter from some makers?)
